

African Sahara Adventure Tour

Arrival and Transfer to Andries Adventures
Upon arrival at the airport, you will be picked up and transferred to Andries Adventures, a charming base where you'll enjoy dinner and spend the night. This will give you time to relax and prepare for the upcoming adventure.

Day 1: Almuñécar (Esp) – Álora (230 km)
We start the journey in Spain, ascending from the Tropical Coast towards the mountains. We cross spectacular mountain passes and the famous La Axarquía wine region. Accommodation at the Don Joaquín hotel in Álora.

Day 2: Álora – Ronda (155 Km)
Ascent through the Sierra de Las Nieves National Park and a visit to Setenil de las Bodegas. Arrival in the historic city of Ronda to admire the famous Tajo and the bullring. Accommodation at the Hotel Don Miguel.

Day 3: Ronda- Tarifa – Tanger – Chefchaouen (145 km)
Descent to Tarifa to take the ferry to Tanger. After customs formalities, route through the Rif mountains to Chefchaouen, the *Blue City*. Night in a traditional riad.

Day 4: Chefchaouen to Fès (206 km)
From Chefchaouen, we continue through mountain roads to the historic city of Fès, where you can explore one of the world's oldest medinas, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Day 5: Fès to Imilchil (349 km)
A long and challenging ride through mountain trails, crossing the rugged Atlas Mountains to reach the remote and picturesque village of Imilchil, renowned for its stunning high-altitude landscapes.

Day 6: Imilchil to Merzouga (311 km)
We descend from the mountains, passing through valleys and reaching Merzouga, at the edge of the Sahara Desert. Experience the transition from green landscapes to desert plains.

Day 7: Merzouga to Merzouga (88 km)
Today, we explore the Erg Chebbi dunes around Merzouga, offering a thrilling day riding through the golden sands of the Sahara Desert. Perfect for honing offroad skills in the iconic desert landscape.

Day 8: Merzouga to Midelt via Plateau de Rekkam (270 km)
We leave the Sahara behind and head north through the famous Plateau de Rekkam, a vast high plain offering spectacular riding conditions with stunning vistas of the surrounding mountains. Overnight in Midelt, a town nestled between the Middle and High Atlas mountains.

Day 9: Midelt to Nador (310 km)
From Midelt, we journey through diverse landscapes toward the Mediterranean coast, eventually reaching the port city of Nador. This route showcases the transition from mountain terrain to coastal environment. Evening preparation for the overnight ferry crossing.

Day 10: Overnight Ferry Nador to Almeria
Board the overnight ferry from Nador to Almeria, Spain. This sea crossing gives riders a chance to rest and reflect on the Moroccan adventure while crossing the Mediterranean. Comfortable cabin accommodations provided on the ferry.

Day 11: Almeria to Almuñécar (160 km)
Our final riding day takes us along the beautiful Spanish Mediterranean coast from Almeria to Almuñécar. Enjoy the coastal scenery and mountain views as we complete our journey back to Andries Adventures base for a farewell dinner and celebration.

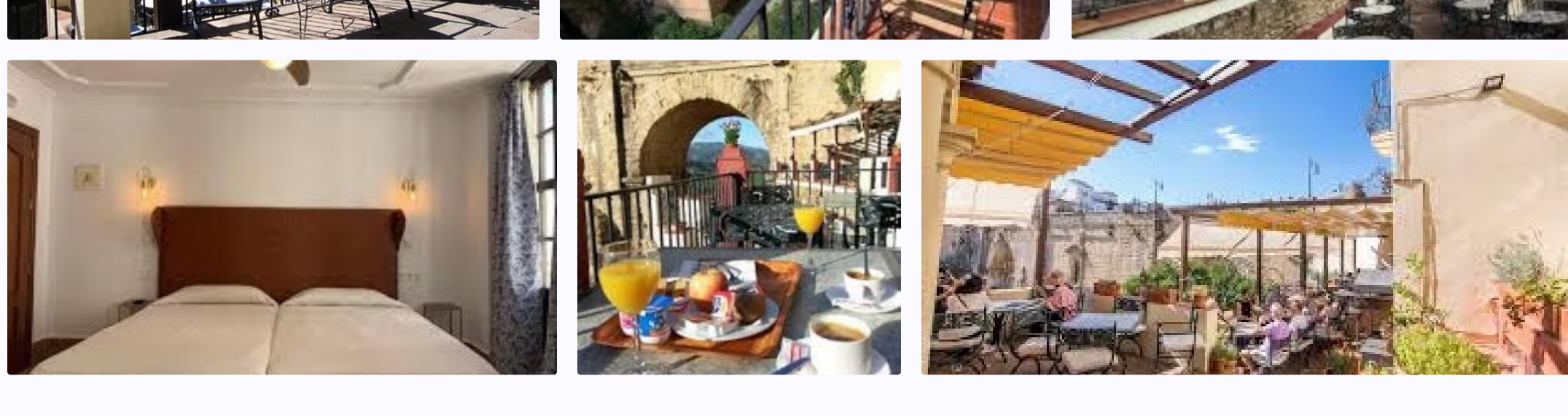
